

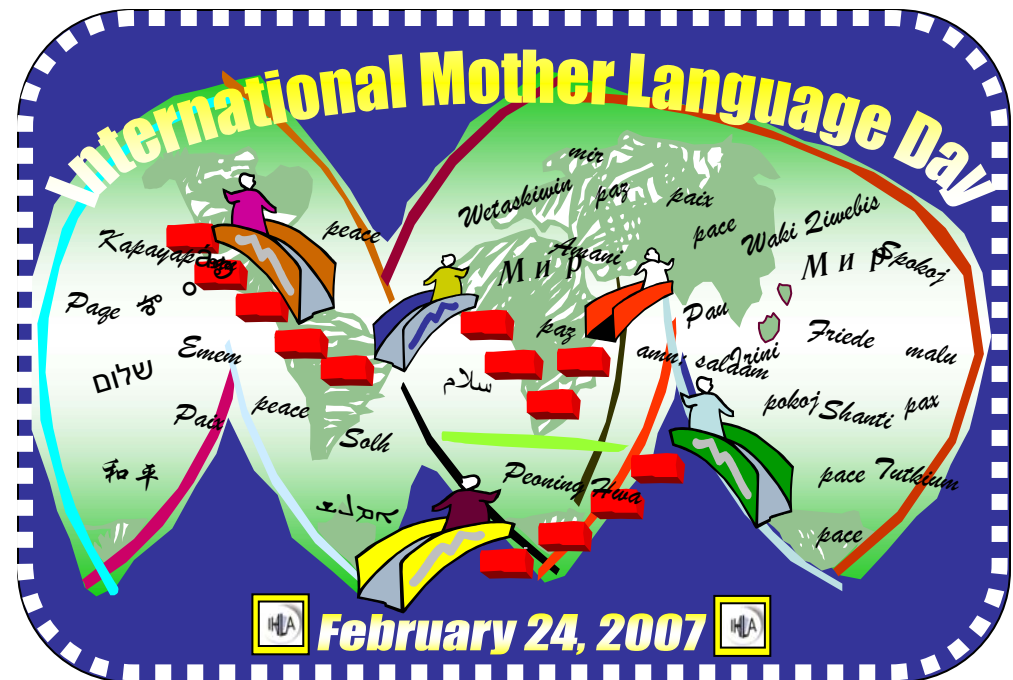

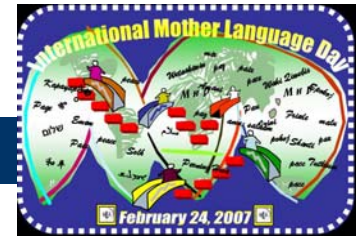

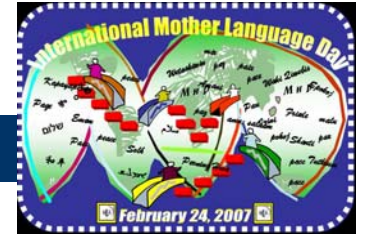

IHLA Schools and Mother Language Day (MLD)



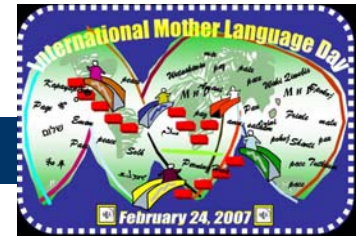
- All IHLA member schools are invited to participate and be actively involved in this event. This year (2007) IHLA schools need to also be part of the Leadership Program to actively participate in this event. MLD is an opportunity for all schools to showcase their programs, be visible in the community and demonstrate their educational support to language education in the province.
- In the past three years IHLA has organized this event that has been attended by about 500 people in the community.

How do IHLA schools Participate?



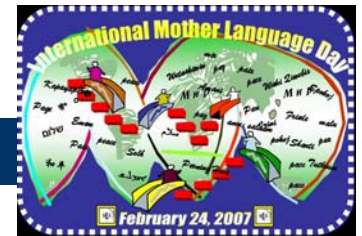
- Schools who wish to be involved in an even more challenging task can **prepare a special skit** on the same theme and will be able to perform the skit during the event.
- IHLA schools who know special **cultural performers** can also contact the IHLA office to contribute their names for a short act during the event.

Book a Display Table



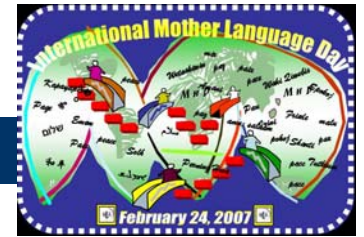
- Tables will be available for bookings – must be set up and cleaned up for the event.
 - Doors open at 9:00 a.m. for set up and the hall must be cleaned between 2:00 and 3:00 p.m.
 - Schools can book two tables. **Bookings must be received by February 3rd, 2006 (form completed and amount deposited at the IHLA office).**
 - Tables can be decorated – no posting option on walls
 - A map will be distributed prior to the event to inform schools of their table location in the hall.
 - All tables will be visited by people participating in the Passport Game.

Passport Game



- Like in previous years people in attendance will be invited to participate in the **Passport Game**.
- Children and families will be picking up a **special passport** which will contain the names of all displays of schools in attendance.
- The passports are distributed free of charge (one per person). They must be filled with stamps from each school. People are to go to the different tables and displays, participate in small activities organized by the table (questions or small tasks that each school prepares) and receive a stamp from that school.
- Once the passport is fully stamped they return to the reception desk and receive a small gift of their choice.
- This game will run between 12:00 a.m. and 1:30 p.m.

Essay Contest

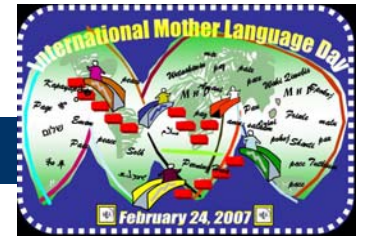


- As each year IHLA school students are invited to demonstrate their linguistic skills by writing a short essay according to the theme of the event, which this year is as follows:

“The Human Race Needs Bridges: Let Our Words Build Them!”

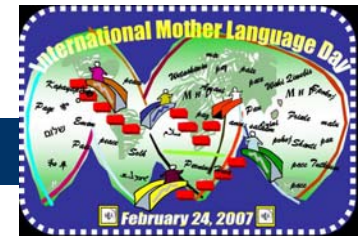
- Essays must be written in the L2 – two pages max – 12 font – double spaced.
- Essays must be also translated in English (approximate translation) and e-mailed to IHLA by **February 3rd, 2007.** (ihla@telus.net)

Essay Contest



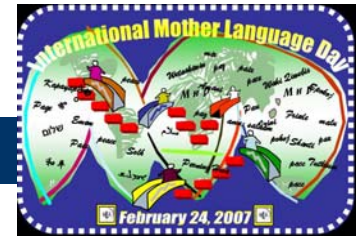
- All essay entries will be acknowledged and will remain property of IHLA – postings will appear on IHLA publications and website.
- All essays will be awarded a certificate that will be handed out by special guests during the event (at about 1:15 p.m.)
- All entries must be accompanied by a signed **FOIP Form**. The forms are included in this package and can be duplicated.

Poster contest



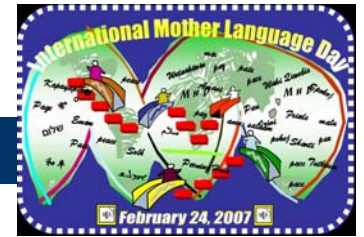
- Earlier grade students can prepare a special poster with the same theme of the essay.
- Poster sizes may vary.
- Posters must be received by IHLA by February 3rd, 2007 (they can be left at the IHLA office).
- Posters may be returned to submitters or remain with IHLA for future reference.
- Pictures of posters will be posted on the website and IHLA publications.
- All Poster contests must be accompanied by a signed FOIP form.

Language Skit



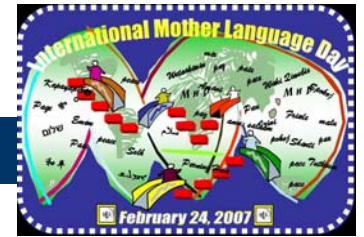
- Schools may choose to participate in the creation and performance of a language skit presentation based on the theme of the event.
- The skit will last no longer than 3 minutes and must represent ways in which language and culture learning and sharing can lower and eliminate racism at all social levels.
- Each skit may have a different title and can be performed in any chosen language.
- All skits will be performed live at the event. (between 12:00 and 1:00 p.m.)
- Skits should not count on great deal of setting requirements on site.
- Schools who choose to perform a skit must register by February 3rd, 2007.

Entertainment Contribution



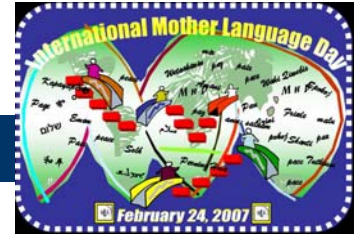
- Schools may want to register their cultural groups for an entertainment act – music, dance, performing arts.
- Each school can present no more than one group for an entertainment act. (we want to open to a variety of groups)
- Each act can be no longer than 3 minutes.
- IHLA will have access to a CD player and a sound system.
- All confirmed entertainment acts must be performed on the day – no performances will be improvised at the last moment.
- All acts will be performed on a voluntary basis.
- All performances must be registered with IHLA by February 3rd, 2007.

How can my school register?



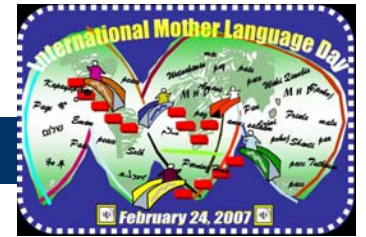
- IHLA expects your school to register in any one of the event parts or in more than one by **February 3rd, 2007.**

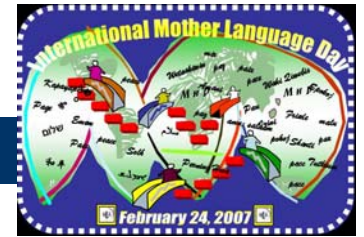

- The success of this event depends on the generosity and commitment of all friends and supporters of IHLA. If your school and community can provide volunteers IHLA will be very appreciative of the support.

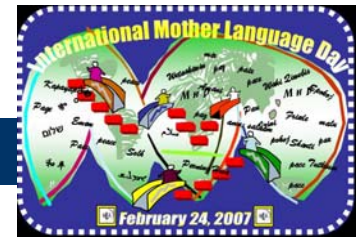
MLD CHECKLIST

- I have contacted IHLA for volunteers to help out with the event.

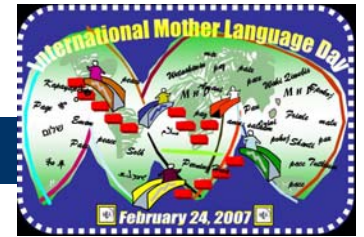
